What will we do?



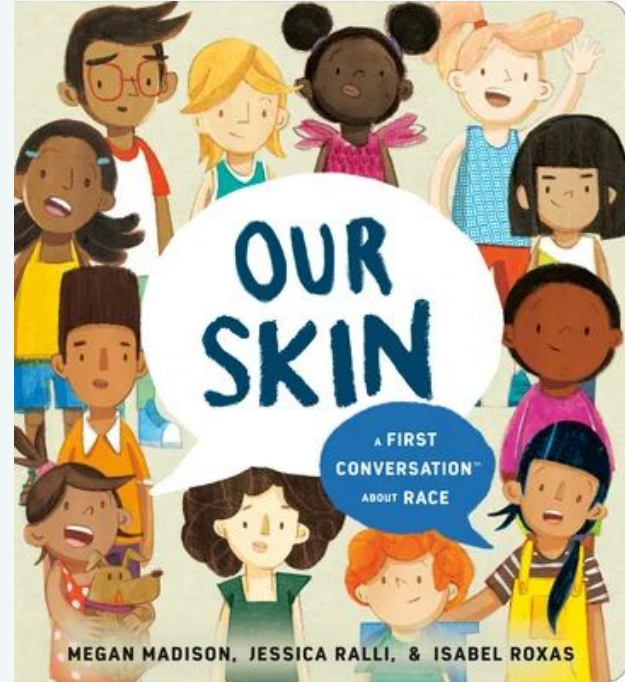
Read a Book

Do you see people who look like you when you read books or watch videos at school?

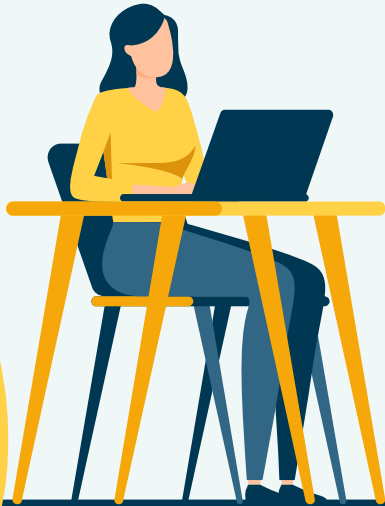
